- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.041, Property Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 21.041. EVIDENCE. (a) As the basis for assessing
- 8 actual damages to a property owner from a condemnation, the special
- 9 commissioners shall admit evidence on:
- 10 (1) the value of the property being condemned;
- 11 (2) the injury to the property owner;
- 12 (3) the benefit to the property owner's remaining
- 13 property; and
- 14 (4) the use of the property for the purpose of the
- 15 condemnation.
- 16 (b) The special commissioners may admit evidence on the
- 17 price paid for pipeline or power line rights-of-way in privately
- 18 negotiated transactions made in the absence of a potential, actual,
- 19 <u>or threatened condemnation.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 21.041, Property Code, as amended by
- 21 this Act, applies only to an eminent domain proceeding commenced on
- 22 or after the effective date of this Act. An eminent domain
- 23 proceeding commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 24 governed by the law applicable to the proceeding immediately before

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- 1 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 2 for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
