- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1702.124, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (c-1), the [The]
- 9 insurance policy must contain minimum limits of:
- 10 (1) \$100,000 for each occurrence for bodily injury and
- 11 property damage;
- 12 (2) \$50,000 for each occurrence for personal injury;
- 13 and
- 14 (3) a total aggregate amount of \$200,000 for all
- 15 occurrences.
- 16 (c-1) If the application is for a license to act as a guard
- 17 company, the insurance policy must contain minimum limits of:
- 18 (1) \$1 million for each occurrence for bodily injury
- 19 and property damage;
- 20 (2) \$1 million for each occurrence for personal
- 21 injury; and
- 22 (3) a total aggregate amount of \$2 million for all
- 23 occurrences.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
