- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 1301, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1301.059 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1301.059. PLUMBING BY PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANIES ON
- 8 CERTAIN PRIVATE PROPERTY. A person is not required to be licensed
- 9 under this chapter to perform plumbing work on behalf of a public
- 10 service company if the person is a public service company or a
- 11 contractor of a public service company who performs plumbing,
- 12 <u>including the installation</u>, service, or repair of service mains,
- 13 service lines, appurtenances, equipment, or appliances that
- 14 provide water, sewer, storm drainage, or gas services, on private
- 15 property in an area that extends from a public easement to not less
- 16 than five feet from a building or structure.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
