A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the disclosure of insurance company affiliates to 3 insurance policyholders. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 525, Insurance Code, is amended by designating Sections 525.001, 525.002, and 525.003 as Subchapter A 6 and adding a subchapter heading to read as follows: 7 SUBCHAPTER A. DELIVERY OF INSURANCE POLICIES BY CERTAIN INSURERS 8 SECTION 2. Sections 525.001, 9 525.002, and 525.003, Insurance Code, are amended to read as follows: 10 Sec. 525.001. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER [CHAPTER]. 11 This 12 subchapter [chapter] applies to: 13 (1) an insurer, as defined by Section 2301.051, 14 writing personal automobile insurance or residential property insurance, as defined by Section 2301.051, in this state; 15 (2) the Texas Windstorm Insurance Association; 16 (3) the FAIR Plan Association; and 17 18 (4) the Texas Automobile Insurance Plan Association. Sec. 525.002. DELIVERY OF INSURANCE POLICIES. (a) Except 19 as provided by Subsection (b), an insurer to whom this subchapter 20 21 [chapter] applies shall deliver a policy issued by the insurer to the policyholder, or to the insurer's agent for delivery to the 22 23 policyholder: (1) not later than: 24

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1	that delivers a policy issued or renewed by the insurer to a
2	policyholder or to the policyholder's agent for delivery to the
3	policyholder shall include with the policy a disclosure of the
4	insurer's affiliates.
5	(b) The disclosure required by Subsection (a) may be
6	delivered electronically in accordance with Section 35.004.
7	SECTION 4. Subchapter B, Chapter 525, Insurance Code, as
8	added by this Act, applies only to an insurance policy that is
9	delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1,
10	2018. An insurance policy delivered, issued for delivery, or
11	renewed before January 1, 2018, is governed by the law as it existed
12	immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
13	continued in effect for that purpose.
14	SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
