A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the licensing and registration of certain assisted
3	living facilities and group home facilities; authorizing the
4	imposition of a civil penalty.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 247.002, Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended by amending Subdivision (1) and adding Subdivision (4-b) to
8	read as follows:
9	(1) "Assisted living facility" means an establishment
10	that:
11	(A) furnishes, in one or more facilities, food
12	and shelter to:
13	(i) four or more persons who are unrelated
14	to the proprietor of the establishment; or
15	(ii) at least one and fewer than four
16	persons who are unrelated to the proprietor of the establishment
17	and at least one of whom has Alzheimer's disease or dementia;
18	(B) provides:
19	(i) personal care services; or
20	(ii) administration of medication by a
21	person licensed or otherwise authorized in this state to administer
22	the medication;
23	(C) may provide assistance with or supervision of
24	the administration of medication; and

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- 1 (D) may provide skilled nursing services for the
- 2 following limited purposes:
- 3 (i) coordination of resident care with
- 4 outside home and community support services agencies and other
- 5 health care professionals;
- 6 (ii) provision or delegation of personal
- 7 care services and medication administration as described by this
- 8 subdivision;
- 9 (iii) assessment of residents to determine
- 10 the care required; and
- 11 (iv) for periods of time as established by
- 12 commission [department] rule, delivery of temporary skilled
- 13 nursing treatment for a minor illness, injury, or emergency.
- 14 (4-b) "Group home facility" means an establishment
- 15 that otherwise meets the definition of an assisted living facility,
- 16 except that the establishment furnishes food and shelter to three
- 17 or fewer persons who are unrelated to the proprietor of the
- 18 establishment.
- 19 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 247, Health and Safety
- 20 Code, is amended by adding Section 247.02101 to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 247.02101. GROUP HOME FACILITY; REGISTRATION
- 22 REQUIRED. (a) A group home facility shall register with the
- 23 commission in the form and manner provided by commission rule.
- 24 (b) A group home facility that fails to register with the
- 25 commission under this section is subject to a civil penalty under
- 26 Section 247.045.
- 27 SECTION 3. Section 247.029, Health and Safety Code, is

- 1 amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsections (e) and
- 2 (f) to read as follows:
- 3 (d) The executive commissioner by rule shall adopt
- 4 definitions [a definition] of "Alzheimer's disease and related
- 5 disorders $[-\tau]$ " and "dementia," and may adopt by reference a
- 6 definition published in a generally accepted clinical resource for
- 7 medical professionals. The executive commissioner shall modify the
- 8 definition as necessary to conform to changes in medical practice.
- 9 (e) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules providing
- 10 for the licensing and operation of an assisted living facility
- 11 described by Section 247.002(1)(A)(ii). The rules must require a
- 12 facility to:
- 13 <u>(1) employ at least one caregiver who:</u>
- 14 (A) has training or experience in providing care
- 15 to persons with Alzheimer's disease or dementia; and
- 16 (B) is able to provide adequate treatment and
- 17 care for each resident with Alzheimer's disease or dementia at the
- 18 facility;
- 19 (2) implement security measures to ensure that
- 20 residents with Alzheimer's disease or dementia do not leave the
- 21 institution unaccompanied or unassisted;
- 22 (3) ensure that a resident leaves the facility only
- 23 when accompanied by:
- (A) a person authorized to accompany the resident
- 25 by the individual responsible for the resident; or
- 26 (B) a medical transportation provider who is
- 27 transporting a resident for scheduled health care services;

- 1 (4) maintain an operational nonwireless telephone
- 2 line at the facility with a telephone number listed in the name of
- 3 the facility or of the controlling person;
- 4 (5) provide:
- 5 (A) bedrooms with sufficient square footage and
- 6 floor space;
- 7 (B) a social-diversional area; and
- 8 (C) appropriate activities for residents;
- 9 (6) obtain permission from the individual responsible
- 10 for a resident before handling the resident's personal finances or
- 11 accepting from a resident money or gifts of financial value;
- 12 (7) maintain regular contact with the individual
- 13 responsible for the resident; and
- 14 (8) refrain from contacting a former resident, an
- 15 individual responsible for a former resident, or an assisted living
- 16 <u>facility where a former resident currently resides.</u>
- 17 (f) An assisted living facility described by Section
- 18 247.002(1)(A)(ii) may not have residing at the facility
- 19 simultaneously a resident with a severe mental illness and a
- 20 resident with Alzheimer's disease or dementia.
- 21 SECTION 4. Section 247.050, Health and Safety Code, is
- 22 repealed.
- 23 SECTION 5. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 24 Human Services Commission shall adopt rules:
- 25 (1) necessary to implement Section 247.02101, Health
- 26 and Safety Code, as added by this Act, not later than January 1,
- 27 2018; and

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- 1 (2) required by Section 247.029, Health and Safety
- 2 Code, as amended by this Act, not later than June 1, 2018.
- 3 SECTION 6. A person is not required to comply with:
- 4 (1) Section 247.02101, Health and Safety Code, as
- 5 added by this Act, until January 1, 2018; and
- 6 (2) Section 247.029, Health and Safety Code, as
- 7 amended by this Act, until June 1, 2018.
- 8 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
