A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to cardiac assessments of high school participants in
3	extracurricular athletic activities sponsored or sanctioned by the
4	University Interscholastic League.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 33.095 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 33.095. CARDIAC ASSESSMENTS OF HIGH SCHOOL
9	PARTICIPANTS IN EXTRACURRICULAR ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES. (a) A school
10	district must require a district student who is required under
11	University Interscholastic League rule or policy to receive a
12	physical examination before being allowed to participate in an
13	athletic activity sponsored or sanctioned by the University
14	Interscholastic League to also have administered to the student an
15	electrocardiogram before being allowed to participate in the
16	activity, including a practice for the activity, as follows:
17	(1) one time before the student's first year of
18	participation at the ninth grade level or above; and
19	(2) another time before the student's third year of
20	participation.
21	(b) This section does not create a cause of action or
22	liability against an appropriately licensed or certified health
23	care professional, a school district, or a district officer or
24	employee for the injury or death of a student participating in or

- 1 practicing for an athletic activity sponsored or sanctioned by the
- 2 University Interscholastic League based on or in connection with
- 3 the administration or evaluation of or reliance on an
- 4 electrocardiogram or on an echocardiogram.
- 5 (c) The University Interscholastic League shall adopt rules
- 6 <u>as necessary to administer this section.</u>
- 7 (d) The rules adopted under Subsection (c) must include:
- 8 (1) criteria under which a school district may
- 9 demonstrate a hardship that allows the district to delay the
- 10 required electrocardiograms to students under this section; and
- 11 (2) provisions that allow for granting a waiver from
- 12 administration of an electrocardiogram under this section to a
- 13 student if, for any reason, the parent of or a person standing in
- 14 parental relation to the student submits a written request for the
- 15 <u>waiver.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2018-2019
- 17 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
