A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the issuance of and the requirements for obtaining 3 certain driver's licenses or identification certificates; 4 authorizing a fee.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Sections 521.009(a), (a-1), and (c),

Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:

8 (a) The department may establish a program for the provision 9 of renewal and duplicate driver's license, election identification 10 certificate, and personal identification certificate services in 11 counties <u>and municipalities</u> that enter into an agreement with the 12 department under Subsection (a-1).

(a-1) Under the program, the department may enter into an agreement with the commissioners court of a county <u>or the governing</u> <u>body of a municipality</u> to permit county <u>or municipal</u> employees to provide services at a county <u>or municipal</u> office relating to the issuance of renewal and duplicate driver's licenses, election identification certificates, and personal identification certificates, including:

(2) administering vision tests;

(3) updating a driver's license, election identification certificate, or personal identification certificate to change a name, address, or photograph;

(4) distributing and collecting information relating
 to donations under Section 521.401;

(5) collecting fees; and

4 (6) performing other basic ministerial functions and
5 tasks necessary to issue renewal and duplicate driver's licenses,
6 election identification certificates, and personal identification
7 certificates.

8 (c) A participating county <u>or municipality</u> must remit to the 9 department for deposit as required by this chapter fees collected 10 for the issuance of a renewal or duplicate driver's license or 11 personal identification certificate.

SECTION 2. Section 521.148, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

(d) This section does not apply to a person who holds a valid
 driver's license issued by this state or another state that
 includes an authorization to operate a motorcycle.

17 SECTION 3. Section 521.1601, Transportation Code, as added 18 by Chapter 1413 (S.B. 1317), Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular 19 Session, 2009, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 521.1601. DRIVER EDUCATION 20 REQUIRED. (a) The department may not issue a driver's license to a person who is 21 younger than 25 years of age unless the person submits to the 22 department a driver education certificate issued under Chapter 23 24 1001, Education Code, that states that the person has completed and 25 passed:

26 (1) a driver education and traffic safety course27 conducted by an entity exempt from licensure under Section

1001.002, Education Code, or a driver education course approved by
 the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation under Chapter
 1001, Education Code; or

4 (2) if the person is 18 years of age or older, a driver
5 education course approved by the Texas Department of Licensing and
6 Regulation under Section 1001.101 or 1001.1015, Education Code.

7 (b) This section does not apply to a person who holds a valid
8 license issued by another state or a foreign country.

9 SECTION 4. Section 521.428, Transportation Code, is amended 10 to read as follows:

11 Sec. 521.428. COUNTY <u>OR MUNICIPAL</u> FEE. A county <u>or</u> 12 <u>municipality</u> that provides services under an agreement described by 13 Section 521.009 may collect an additional fee of up to \$5 for each 14 transaction provided that relates to driver's license and personal 15 identification certificate services only.

16 SECTION 5. Section 522.034, Transportation Code, is amended 17 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

18 (d) This section does not apply to a person who holds a valid 19 driver's license issued by this state or another state that 20 includes an authorization to operate a motorcycle.

21 22 SECTION 6. The following are repealed:

(1) Section 521.124, Transportation Code; and

(2) Section 521.1601, Transportation Code, as added by
Chapter 1253 (H.B. 339), Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular
Session, 2009.

26 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
