1-22 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-23 AN ACT

1-24 relating to the use of municipal hotel occupancy tax revenue by
 1-25 certain municipalities.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 351, Tax Code, is amended
 1-28 by adding Section 351.1079 to read as follows:

1-29 Sec. 351.1079. ALLOCATION OF REVENUE FOR SPORTS FACILITIES
 1-30 AND FIELDS BY CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES. (a) This section applies
 1-31 only to a municipality that has a population of at least 6,000 and
 1-32 that is the county seat of a county that:

- 1-33 (1) borders the State of Louisiana;
- 1-34 (2) is bisected by a United States highway; and
- 1-35 (3) has a population of 75,000 or less.

1-36 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter and
 1-37 subject to Subsection (c), a municipality to which this section
 1-38 applies may use all or any portion of the revenue derived from the
 1-39 municipal hotel occupancy tax to construct, improve, maintain, and
 1-40 operate sports facilities and fields for the purpose of promoting
 1-41 tourism and the convention and hotel industry.

1-42 (c) A municipality to which this section applies may use
 1-43 revenue derived from the municipal hotel occupancy tax to:

- 1-44 (1) maintain or operate sports facilities and fields
 1-45 only if the conditions specified by Sections 351.101(a)(7)(A) and
 1-46 (C) are met; and
- 1-47 (2) improve a sports facility or field only if the
 1-48 requirements of Sections 351.101(a)(7)(A) and (C) are met and the
 1-49 municipality complies with Section 351.1076.

1-50 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-51 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-52 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-53 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-54 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
