8	possible, the commission's office of inspector general shall ensure
9	that for hospitals, hospital systems, and other providers subject
10	to audit by the office there is no disparity in the number of times:
11	(1) each hospital is audited by the office compared to
12	the number of times all other hospitals are audited;
13	(2) each hospital system is audited by the office
14	compared to the number of times all other hospital systems are
15	audited; and
16	(3) each other provider is audited by the office
17	compared to the number of times all other providers are audited.
18	(b) Subsection (a) only applies to routine audits conducted
