- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 6.406, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (c) to read as follows:

- 7 (c) If the suit for dissolution of a marriage includes a
- 8 suit affecting the parent-child relationship under Subsection (b),
- 9 the court shall provide the parties with a written notice that
- 10 includes the following statement:
- "It is the policy of the State of Texas that the best
- 12 interests of the child shall always be the primary consideration of
- 13 courts when determining issues of conservatorship and possession of
- 14 and access to children in family law matters. Issues involving
- 15 children of parents who are divorced or separated can often be very
- 16 challenging for everyone involved. Parents are encouraged to seek
- 17 out and utilize available resources and support organizations in
- 18 their communities that can assist them in facilitating successful
- 19 co-parenting of their children."
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to a suit for dissolution of a marriage filed on or after the
- 22 effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
