A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to an innovation grant program for community faith-based
- 3 programs that collaborate with the Department of Family and
- 4 Protective Services to improve foster care.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 264, Family Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 264.2042 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 264.2042. GRANTS FOR FAITH-BASED COMMUNITY
- 9 COLLABORATIVE PROGRAMS. (a) Using available funds or private
- 10 donations, the governor shall establish and administer an
- 11 innovation grant program to award grants to support faith-based
- 12 community programs that collaborate with the department and the
- 13 commission to improve foster care and the placement of children in
- 14 <u>foster care.</u>

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- 15 (b) A faith-based community program is eligible for a grant
- 16 under this section if:
- 17 (1) the effectiveness of the program is supported by
- 18 <u>empirical evidence; and</u>
- (2) the program has demonstrated the ability to build
- 20 connections between faith-based, secular, and government
- 21 stakeholders.
- (c) The regional director for the department in the region
- 23 where a grant recipient program is located, or the regional
- 24 director's designee, shall serve as the liaison between the

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- 1 department and the program for collaborative purposes. For a
- 2 program that operates in a larger region, the department may
- 3 designate a liaison in each county where the program is operating.
- 4 The department or the commission may not direct or manage the
- 5 operation of the program.
- 6 (d) The initial duration of a grant under this section is
- 7 two years. The governor may renew a grant awarded to a program
- 8 under this section if funds are available and the governor
- 9 determines that the program is successful.
- 10 (e) The governor may not award to a program grants under
- 11 this section totaling more than \$300,000.
- 12 (f) The governor shall adopt rules to implement the grant
- 13 program created under this section.
- 14 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 15 of this Act, the governor shall adopt rules for the implementation
- 16 and administration of the innovation grant program established
- 17 under Section 264.2042, Family Code, as added by this Act, and begin
- 18 to award grants under the program.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
