6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 264, Family Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 264.2042 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 264.2042. GRANTS FOR FAITH-BASED COMMUNITY
9	COLLABORATIVE PROGRAMS. (a) Subject to the availability of funds,
10	the department shall establish and administer an innovation grant
11	program to award grants to support faith-based community programs
12	that collaborate with the department and the commission to improve
13	foster care and the placement of children in foster care.
14	(b) A faith-based community program is eligible for a grant
15	under this section if:
16	(1) the effectiveness of the program is supported by
17	empirical evidence; and
18	(2) the program has demonstrated the ability to build

- SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 14 of this Act, the Department of Family and Protective Services shall
- 15 adopt rules for the implementation and administration of the
- 16 innovation grant program established under Section 264.2042,
- 17 Family Code, as added by this Act, and begin to award grants under
- 18 the program.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
