Section 6311), and its subsequent 10 11 amendments], to provide notice to a parent or guardian regarding a 12 teacher who does not meet certification requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher is assigned [is not 13 14 highly qualified], provided the school provides notice as required by that Act. 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18
