## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the appointment of the commissioner of agriculture.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 11.004, Agriculture Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 11.004. APPOINTMENT [ELECTION] AND TERM OF
- 7 COMMISSIONER. (a) The governor shall appoint the commissioner
- 8 with the advice and consent of the senate [is elected for a term of
- 9 four years].
- 10 (b) The commissioner's term of office runs concurrently
- 11 with the governor's.
- 12 <u>(c) The governor shall appoint another person as</u>
- 13 commissioner, with the advice and consent of the senate, to fill a
- 14 vacancy in the office of commissioner.
- 15 (d) The governor shall appoint the commissioner without
- 16 regard to the race, color, disability, sex, religion, age, or
- 17 national origin of the appointee.
- SECTION 2. Section 11.005(a), Agriculture Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 (a) To be eligible for <u>appointment</u> [election] as
- 21 commissioner [or appointment to fill a vacancy in the office of
- 22 commissioner], a person must satisfy the requirements for holding
- 23 elective office under Section 141.001, Election Code, and must:
- 24 (1) have been engaged, for at least five of the 10

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- 1 years preceding the year in which the person is [elected or]
- 2 appointed to the person's initial term, in the business of
- 3 agriculture;
- 4 (2) have worked, for the five-year period preceding
- 5 the calendar year in which the person is [elected or] appointed to
- 6 the person's initial term, for a state or federal agency in a
- 7 position directly related to agriculture;
- 8 (3) have owned or operated, for at least five of the 10
- 9 years preceding the year in which the person is [elected or]
- 10 appointed to the person's initial term, farm, ranch, or timber land
- 11 that qualifies for agricultural use appraisal under Subchapter C,
- 12 Chapter 23, Tax Code, and be participating, in the calendar year in
- 13 which the person is [elected or] appointed to the person's initial
- 14 term, in a farm program administered by the federal Farm Service
- 15 Agency [Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service]; or
- 16 (4) have worked, for at least five years at any time
- 17 before the calendar year in which the person is [elected or]
- 18 appointed to the person's initial term, for the Texas Agriculture
- 19 [Agricultural] Council, an organization that is a member of the
- 20 Texas <u>Agriculture</u> [Agricultural] Council, or another agricultural
- 21 producer association.
- 22 SECTION 3. Section 58.025, Agriculture Code, is amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- Sec. 58.025. PUBLIC HEARINGS. The administrator, the
- 25 commissioner, or an individual designated by the commissioner may
- 26 conduct public hearings relating to issuance of the authority's
- 27 bonds or the implementation of financial assistance, and the

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- 1 governor [commissioner] may act as the applicable elected
- 2 representative for purposes of approving any bonds or financial
- 3 assistance required to be approved, including any approval required
- 4 under Section 147(f), [of the] Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 52.092(c), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (c) Statewide offices of the state government shall be
- 8 listed in the following order:
- 9 (1) governor;
- 10 (2) lieutenant governor;
- 11 (3) attorney general;
- 12 (4) comptroller of public accounts;
- 13 (5) commissioner of the General Land Office;
- 14 (6) [commissioner of agriculture;
- 15  $\left[\frac{(7)}{}\right]$  railroad commissioner;
- 16 (7) [(8)] chief justice, supreme court;
- 17 (8) [<del>(9)</del>] justice, supreme court;
- 18 (9) [<del>(10)</del>] presiding judge, court of criminal
- 19 appeals;
- 20 (10) [<del>(11)</del>] judge, court of criminal appeals.
- 21 SECTION 5. (a) The term of office of the commissioner of
- 22 agriculture expires on the effective date of this Act.
- 23 (b) As soon as practicable on or after the effective date of
- 24 this Act, the governor shall appoint a person to the office of
- 25 commissioner of agriculture in the manner provided by Section
- 26 11.004, Agriculture Code, as amended by this Act.
- 27 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
