16	(1) affect the validity or priority of a security interest

18	agricultural producer;
19	(2) affect the validity or priority of a cotton ginner's

21	(3) apply to a contract purchaser who purchases an
22	agricultural crop from an agricultural producer pursuant to a
23	marketing contract created under Section 52.016, Agriculture Code,
