- 2 relating to the maintenance of the statewide voter registration
- 3 list.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 18.061, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (f), (g), and (h) to read as follows:
- 7 (f) The secretary of state may contract with an entity that
- 8 utilizes secure data to verify change of address information for
- 9 the purpose of managing the statewide computerized voter
- 10 registration list.
- 11 (g) The secretary of state may make verified clerical
- 12 changes to the statewide computerized voter registration list based
- 13 on information received under this subchapter in a manner that
- 14 produces the least possible impact on the voters in this state and
- 15 fulfills the secretary of state's responsibility to manage the
- 16 voter rolls. The secretary of state shall send notice of any
- 17 <u>clerical changes to the voter registrar of the counties considered</u>
- 18 appropriate by the secretary.
- 19 (h) The secretary of state may adopt rules and prescribe
- 20 procedures for the implementation of this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 18.062, Election Code, is amended by
- 22 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- (c) For the voter registration purposes of participating in
- 24 a system developed under this section, the secretary of state may

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- 1 disclose voter information, including a voter's date of birth and
- 2 the last four digits of a voter's social security number.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
