2	relating to the operations of the Ector County Hospital District.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Sections 1024.051(a) and (d),
5	Special District Local Laws Code are amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 1024.051 BOARD ELECTION; TERMS. (a) The district is
7	governed by a board of seven directors in single-member districts.
8	(d) An election shall be held on the uniform election date
9	in May of each <u>odd-numbered</u> [even-numbered] year to elect the
10	appropriate number of directors.
11	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 1024, Special District
12	Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 1024.0545 to read as
13	follows:
14	Sec. 1024.0545. GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL. (a) It is a ground for
15	removal from the board that a director is absent from more than half
16	of the regularly scheduled board meetings that the director is
17	eligible to attend in any 12-month period without an excuse
18	approved by a majority vote of the board.
19	(b) The validity of an action of the board is not affected by
20	the fact that the action is taken when a ground for removal of a
21	director exists.
22	(c) A director may be removed for a ground provided by this
23	section using the procedures provided by Subchapter B, Chapter 87,
24	Local Government Code, for removing a county official.

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1 SECTION 3. (a) The legislature validates and confirms all 2 governmental acts and proceedings of the board of directors of the 3 Ector County Hospital District that were taken before the effective 4 date of this Act.

5 (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the 6 effective date of this Act:

7 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation ultimately
8 results in the matter being held invalid by a final court judgment;
9 or

10 (2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment.

SECTION 4. Section 1024.051(b), Special District Local Laws
Code, is repealed.

13 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
