## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the Texas Crime Stoppers Council.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 414.004, Government Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 414.004. DIRECTOR. The [council and the] executive
- 7 director of the criminal justice division of the governor's office,
- 8 with input from the council, shall designate a person to serve as
- 9 director. [The director must be approved by the governor.] The
- 10 <u>executive director</u> [council] shall <u>consult with the council to</u>
- 11 define the director's authority and responsibilities.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 414.012, Government Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 414.012. STATEWIDE CRIME REPORTING SYSTEMS [TOLL-FREE
- 15 TELEPHONE SERVICE]. The council shall establish  $\underline{a}$  statewide [ $\underline{a}$ nd
- 16 operate a toll-free] telephone service and other appropriate
- 17 systems to allow information about criminal acts to be reported to
- 18 <u>the council</u> and <u>shall</u> make the <u>telephone</u> service <u>and other</u>
- 19 reporting systems accessible at all times to persons residing in
- 20 areas of the state not served by a crime stoppers organization [for
- 21 reporting to the council information about criminal acts]. [The
- 22 toll-free service must be available between the hours of 5 p.m. and
- 23 8 a.m. Monday through Thursday and from 5 p.m. Friday until 8 a.m.
- 24 Monday. The council shall forward the information received to

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- 1 appropriate law enforcement agencies or crime stoppers
- 2 organization.
- 3 SECTION 3. Article 102.013(a), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 4 is amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) The legislature shall appropriate funds from the crime
- 6 stoppers assistance account to the Criminal Justice Division of the
- 7 Governor's Office. The Criminal Justice Division may use 10
- 8 percent of the funds for the operation of the statewide [toll=free]
- 9 telephone service or other appropriate systems for the reporting of
- 10 <u>crime</u> under Section 414.012, Government Code, and shall distribute
- 11 the remainder of the funds only to crime stoppers organizations.
- 12 The Criminal Justice Division may adopt a budget and rules to
- 13 implement the distribution of these funds.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
