A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to appraisal criteria for assessing performance of public 3 school teachers. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.351(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) The commissioner shall adopt a recommended appraisal process and criteria on which to appraise the performance of 8 9 teachers. The criteria must be based on observable, job-related behavior, including: 10 11 (1) teachers' implementation of discipline management 12 procedures; and 13 (2) the performance of teachers' students, provided 14 that consideration of student performance is not based in any part on student performance on assessment instruments administered 15 16 under Section 39.023. SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 17 school year. 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
