Section 411.383(b), Government Code, is amended 4 to read as follows: 5 6 (b) The director shall adopt rules and issue directives as 7 necessary to ensure proper implementation of the alert. The rules and directives must include: 8 9 (1) the procedures to be used by a local law enforcement agency to verify whether a senior citizen: 10 11 (A) is missing; and 12 (B) has a mental or physical disability or other 13 [an] impaired mental or physical condition; 14 (2) a description of the circumstances under which a local law enforcement agency is required to report a missing senior 15 citizen to the department; and 16 17 (3) the procedures to be used by an individual or 18 entity to report information about a missing senior citizen to designated media outlets in Texas. 19 20 SECTION 2. Section 411.386, Government Code, is amended to 21 read as follows: 22 Sec. 411.386. NOTIFICATION TO DEPARTMENT OF MISSING SENIOR 23 CITIZEN. (a) A local law enforcement agency may notify the department if the agency: 24

(1) receives notice of a missing senior citizen;

2 (2) verifies that at the time the senior citizen is3 reported missing:

4 (A) the person reported missing is 65 years of 5 age or older;

6 (B) the senior citizen's location is unknown; and

(C) the senior citizen has <u>a mental or physical</u>
<u>disability or other</u> [an] impaired mental <u>or physical</u> condition; and
(3) determines that the senior citizen's disappearance
poses a credible threat to the senior citizen's health and safety.

11 (b) The local law enforcement agency shall:

(1) require the family or legal guardian of the missing senior citizen to provide documentation of the senior citizen's <u>mental or physical disability or other</u> impaired mental <u>or</u> <u>physical</u> condition to verify the <u>disability or</u> condition as required by Subsection (a)(2)(C); and

17 (2) as soon as practicable, determine whether the 18 senior citizen's disappearance poses a credible threat to the 19 senior citizen's health and safety for purposes of Subsection 20 (a)(3).

21 SECTION 3. Chapter 411, Government Code, is amended by 22 adding Subchapter P to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER P. ALERT FOR MISSING ADULTS

Sec. 411.441. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:

25 (1) "Adult" means a person who is 18 years of age or
26 older but younger than 65 years of age.

10	Sec. 411.443. ADMINISTRATION. (a) The director is the

12	(b) The director shall adopt rules and issue directives as
13	necessary to ensure proper implementation of the alert. The rules
14	and directives must include:
15	(1) the procedures to be used by a local law
16	enforcement agency to verify whether an adult is:

18	(B) in danger because of the adult's mental or
19	physical disability or other mental or physical condition;

DEPARTMENT TO RECRUIT PARTICIPANTS. 1 The department shall recruit public and commercial television and radio 2 broadcasters, private commercial entities, state or local 3 governmental entities, the public, and other appropriate persons to 4 5 assist in developing and implementing the alert system. 6 Sec. 411.445. STATE AGENCIES. (a) A state agency 7 participating in the alert system shall: (1) cooperate with the department and assist in 8 developing and implementing the alert system; and 9 10 (2) establish a plan for providing relevant information to its officers, investigators, or employees, as 11 12 appropriate, once the alert system has been activated. (b) In addition to its duties as a state agency under 13 Subsection (a), the Texas Department of Transportation shall 14 15 establish a plan for providing relevant information to the public through an existing system of dynamic message signs located across 16 17 the state. Sec. 411.446. NOTIFICATION TO DEPARTMENT OF MISSING ADULT. 18 19 (a) A local law enforcement agency shall notify the department if 20 the agency: 21 (1) receives notice of a missing adult; 22 (2) verifies that at the time the adult is reported 23 missing: 24 (A) the person reported missing is 18 years of age or older but younger than 65 years of age; 25 26 (B) the adult's location is unknown; and 27 (C) the adult has been missing for less than 72

2	(3) confirms that a preliminary investigation has
3	taken place with respect to the disappearance and that, as a result
4	of that investigation, the agency believes that the missing adult
5	is in danger because of the adult's mental or physical disability or
6	other mental or physical condition; and
7	(4) believes sufficient information is available to
8	disseminate to the public that could assist in locating the adult or
9	a vehicle being used by the adult.
10	(b) The department may modify the criteria described by
11	Subsection (a) as necessary for the proper implementation of the
12	alert system.
13	Sec. 411.447. ACTIVATION OF ALERT. (a) When a local law
14	enforcement agency notifies the department under Section 411.446,
15	the department shall confirm the accuracy of the information and,
16	if confirmed, immediately issue an alert under this subchapter in
17	accordance with department rules.
18	(b) In issuing the alert, the department shall send the
19	alert to designated media outlets in Texas. Following receipt of
20	the alert, participating radio stations and television stations and
21	other participating media outlets may issue the alert at designated
22	intervals to assist in locating the missing adult.
23	(c) The department shall also send the alert to:
24	(1) any appropriate local law enforcement agency; and
25	(2) the Texas Department of Transportation.
26	Sec. 411.448. CONTENT OF ALERT. The alert must include:
27	(1) all appropriate information that is provided by

1 the local law enforcement agency under Section 411.446 and that may lead to the safe recovery of the missing adult; and 2 3 (2) a statement instructing any person with information related to the missing adult to contact a local law 4 5 enforcement agency. 6 Sec. 411.449. TERMINATION OF ALERT. (a) The director shall 7 terminate any activation of the alert with respect to a particular 8 missing adult not later than the earlier of the date on which: (1) the missing adult is located or the situation is 9 10 otherwise resolved; or (2) the notification period ends, as determined by 11 12 department rule. (b) A local law enforcement agency that locates a missing 13 14 adult who is the subject of an alert under this subchapter shall 15 notify the department as soon as possible that the missing adult has been located. 16 SECTION 4. Not later than December 1, 2017, the public 17 safety director of the Department of Public Safety of the State of 18 19 Texas shall adopt rules as necessary to implement Sections 411.383 and 411.386, Government Code, as amended by this Act, and 20 Subchapter P, Chapter 411, Government Code, as added by this Act. 21 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017. 2.2
