1	AN ACT
2	relating to funding for apprenticeship training programs through a
3	lottery game.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 133, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 133.0035 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 133.0035. FUND FOR APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING PROGRAMS.
8	(a) The fund for apprenticeship training programs is a special fund
9	held in trust outside the state treasury by the commission. The
10	<pre>fund is composed of:</pre>
11	(1) money transferred to the fund at the direction of
12	the legislature;
13	(2) gifts and grants contributed to the fund;
14	(3) the earnings of the fund; and
15	(4) money transferred to the fund from proceeds of the
16	lottery game operated under Section 466.0271 or transferred to the
17	fund under Section 466.355(b).

- (b) Money in the fund may be spent without appropriation 18
- 19 only for apprenticeship training programs approved by the
- 20 commission under this chapter.
- 21 (c) The commission may adopt rules governing the award of
- grants by the commission under this section. 22
- 23 (d) To carry out any purpose of this chapter, the commission
- may solicit, accept, or refuse a gift, grant, devise, bequest of 24

- 1 money, security, service, or property, including money raised or a
- 2 service provided by a volunteer or volunteer group, to promote the
- 3 work of the commission for any purpose related to the fund for
- 4 apprenticeship training programs.
- 5 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 466, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 466.0271 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 466.0271. APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING PROGRAMS GAME. (a)
- 8 The commission shall operate an instant-ticket lottery game to
- 9 benefit the fund for apprenticeship training programs under Section
- 10 <u>133.0035</u>, Education Code.
- 11 (b) The commission shall:
- 12 (1) determine the ticket price, payout amounts, and
- 13 manner in which the game is conducted;
- 14 (2) make tickets to the game available for sale
- 15 continuously to the extent practicable; and
- 16 (3) change the design or theme of the game regularly to
- 17 ensure that the game remains competitive with other instant-ticket
- 18 lottery games offered by the commission.
- 19 (c) The commission shall market and advertise the lottery
- 20 game operated under this section in a manner intended to inform the
- 21 public that the game tickets are available for purchase and that the
- 22 game proceeds are used to fund apprenticeship training programs in
- 23 this state. The Texas Workforce Commission may make
- 24 recommendations to the Texas Lottery Commission relating to the
- 25 marketing and advertising of the game.
- 26 (d) The commission shall encourage each sales agent that
- 27 sells tickets to instant-ticket games or similar types of lottery

- 1 games to sell tickets to the game operated under this section.
- 2 (e) An organization otherwise eligible to receive money
- 3 from the state lottery account attributable to a lottery game
- 4 authorized by this section may not receive the money if the
- 5 organization conducts illegal gambling or operates illegal
- 6 gambling devices as defined by Chapter 47, Penal Code, or allows the
- 7 conduct of illegal gambling or the operation of illegal gambling
- 8 devices on its property or in its facilities.
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 466.355(b), Government Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (b) Money in the state lottery account may be used only for
- 12 the following purposes and shall be distributed as follows:
- 13 (1) the payment of prizes to the holders of winning
- 14 tickets;
- 15 (2) the payment of costs incurred in the operation and
- 16 administration of the lottery, including any fees received by a
- 17 lottery operator, provided that the costs incurred in a fiscal
- 18 biennium may not exceed an amount equal to 12 percent of the gross
- 19 revenue accruing from the sale of tickets in that biennium;
- 20 (3) the establishment of a pooled bond fund, lottery
- 21 prize reserve fund, unclaimed prize fund, and prize payment
- 22 account; and
- 23 (4) the balance, after creation of a reserve
- 24 sufficient to pay the amounts needed or estimated to be needed under
- 25 Subdivisions (1) through (3), to be transferred on or before the
- 26 15th day of each month as follows:
- 27 (A) the portion of the balance attributable to

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- 1 the lottery game operated under Section 466.027 to the fund for
- veterans' assistance established by Section 434.017; [and]
- 3 (B) the portion of the balance attributable to
- 4 the lottery game operated under Section 466.0271 to the fund for
- 5 apprenticeship training programs established by Section 133.0035,
- 6 Education Code; and
- 7 (C) the remainder to the foundation school fund.
- 8 SECTION 4. (a) Section 466.355(b), Government Code, as
- 9 amended by this Act, applies only to a transfer from the state
- 10 lottery account made on or after January 1, 2018.
- 11 (b) The Texas Lottery Commission shall establish and begin
- 12 selling tickets to the lottery game as required by Section
- 13 466.0271, Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 14 January 1, 2018.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
