BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 56.003(b), Government Code, is amended 5 to read as follows:

(b) No more than one-third of the funds appropriated for any 6 fiscal year shall be used for the continuing legal education of 7 judges of appellate courts, district courts, county courts at law, 8 county courts performing judicial functions, full-time associate 9 judges and masters appointed pursuant to Chapter 201, Family Code, 10 and [full-time] masters, magistrates, referees, and associate 11 12 judges appointed pursuant to Chapter 54 or 54A as required by the court of criminal appeals under Section 74.025 and of their court 13 14 personnel.
