(c) The commission shall waive the fee for: 16 (1) a qualified disabled veteran as defined by Section 17 42.012 and for a resident on active duty as a member of the United 18 States military forces, the Texas Army National Guard, the Texas 19 Air National Guard, or the Texas State Guard; and 20 21 (2) a resident who is 65 years old or over. 22 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies only to a fee charged for a fishing license issued on or after the 23 effective date of this Act. 24

issued, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
The Parks and Wildlife Department is not required to issue a refund
for any license issued before the effective date of this Act.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
