- 8 Sec. 434.451. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only
- 9 to the spouse or former spouse of a veteran, as defined by Section
- 10 2303.003, who was married for at least 10 years to the veteran while
- 11 the veteran served on active duty as a member of the state military
- 12 forces or a component of the United States armed forces, including
- 13 <u>an auxiliary service of one of those branches.</u>

- 15 Notwithstanding the applicability of any other law, the spouse or

- 18 entitled under state law.
- 19 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to an
- 20 application for a state mental health benefit that is submitted by a
- 21 spouse or former spouse of a veteran on or after the effective date
- 22 of this Act.
