relating to the definition of abortion.

Section 33.001(1), Family Code, is amended to 4 SECTION 1. 5 read as follows: 6 (1)"Abortion" has the meaning assigned by Section 7 245.002, Health and Safety Code [means the use of any means +0 terminate the pregnancy of a female known by the attending 8 9 physician to be pregnant, with the intention that the termination of the pregnancy by those means will with reasonable likelihood 10 cause the death of the fetus. This definition, as applied in this 11 12 chapter, applies only to an unemancipated minor known by the 13 attending physician to be pregnant and may not be construed to limit 14 a minor's access to contraceptives].

15 SECTION 2. Section 161.006(b), Family Code, is amended to 16 read as follows:

(b) In this code, "abortion" <u>has the meaning assigned by</u> <u>Section 245.002, Health and Safety Code</u> [means an intentional <u>expulsion of a human fetus from the body of a woman induced by any</u> <u>means for the purpose of causing the death of the fetus</u>].

21 SECTION 3. Section 170.001(1), Health and Safety Code, is 22 amended to read as follows:

(1) "Abortion" <u>has the meaning assigned by Section</u>
<u>245.002</u> [means an act involving the use of an instrument, medicine,

11	intrauterine pregnancy of a woman, including the elimination of one
12	or more unborn children in a multifetal pregnancy, and with
13	knowledge that the termination by those means will, with reasonable
14	likelihood, cause the death of the woman's unborn child. An act is
15	not an abortion if the act is done with the intent to:
