1-20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-21	SECTION 1. Section 11.063, Parks and Wildlife Code, is

1-23	Sec. 11.063. USES OF ACCOUNT. To the extent allowed by
1-24	federal law, money in the lifetime license endowment fund and
1-25	interest [Interest] earned on the lifetime license endowment
1-26	account may be used only for the purpose of managing the fish and
1-27	wildlife resources of this state, as follows [to]:
1-28	(1) acquiring [acquire] public hunting and fishing

1-30	(2) developing, managing, and repairing [develop,
