3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 57.051, Water Code, is amended to read as
5	follows:
6	Sec. 57.051. APPOINTMENT OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS. (a) The
7	commissioners court which creates a levee improvement district
8	under this chapter, by majority vote, shall appoint three directors
9	for the district.
0	(b) The governing body of a levee improvement district
1	consisting of three directors appointed by commissioners court may

- 10 (b) The governing body of a levee improvement district
 11 consisting of three directors appointed by commissioners court may
 12 petition commissioners court to increase the total number of
 13 directors serving on the governing body of the levee improvement
 14 district. Upon receipt of a petition under this subsection,
 15 commissioners court may appoint up to two additional directors to
 16 serve on the governing body of the district.
- SECTION 2. Section 57.058, Water Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 57.058. NUMBER OF ELECTED DIRECTORS; TERMS. In districts which have elected boards, there shall be five directors on the board. All five directors [In countywide districts, one director] shall be elected by the electors of the entire district. The initial elected directors shall draw lots to determine which two initial directors serve two-year terms and which three initial

- 1 <u>directors serve four-year terms</u> [and one director elected from each
- 2 county commissioners precinct by the electors of that precinct. In
- 3 other districts, all five directors shall be elected from precincts
- 4 within the district to be established by the commissioners court].
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 57.060, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 57.060. PETITION. Before an election is held under
- 8 Section 57.057, a petition, signed by at least 10 percent of the
- 9 total number of [100] electors in the district who are qualified to
- 10 vote, shall be presented to the district requesting that an
- 11 election be held in the district to determine whether or not
- 12 directors for the district should be elected [and, if so, to elect
- 13 directors to serve until the next regular director election. The
- 14 petition shall include the name of one or more nominees for each
- 15 director's position]. If the results of an election held under
- 16 <u>Section 57.057</u> determine that directors will be elected, the
- 17 current directors continue to serve until the elected directors
- 18 qualify to take office.
- 19 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by Section 57.058, Water
- 20 Code, as amended by this Act, apply only to an election of directors
- 21 held on or after the effective date of this Act. An election of
- 22 directors held before the effective date of this Act is subject to
- 23 the law in effect on the date the election is held, and that law is
- 24 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
