## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT	

- 2 relating to the approval by the Texas Department of Transportation
- 3 of certain transportation projects of a regional mobility
- 4 authority.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 370.038(a), Transportation Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The commission shall adopt rules that:
- 9 (1) govern the creation of an authority;
- 10 (2) govern [the commission's approval of a project
- 11 under Section 370.187 and other] commission approvals required by
- 12 this chapter;
- 13 (3) establish design and construction standards for a
- 14 transportation project that will connect with a highway in the
- 15 state highway system or a department rail facility;
- 16 (4) establish minimum audit and reporting
- 17 requirements and standards;
- 18 (5) establish minimum ethical standards for authority
- 19 directors and employees; and
- 20 (6) govern the authority of an authority to contract
- 21 with the United Mexican States or a state of the United Mexican
- 22 States.
- SECTION 2. Section 370.187(b), Transportation Code, is
- 24 amended to read as follows:

- 1 (b) The commission by rule shall establish procedures and
- 2 criteria for the department's [an] approval of a transportation
- 3 project that will connect with a highway in the state highway system
- 4 or a department rail facility [under this section]. The procedures
- 5 and criteria [rules] must:
- 6 (1) be based on safety and operational considerations;
- 7 and
- 8 (2) require the department [commission] to consider a
- 9 request for project approval not later than the 60th day after the
- 10 date the department receives all information reasonably necessary
- 11 to review the request.
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 370.187(a), Transportation Code, is
- 13 repealed.
- 14 SECTION 4. Section 370.187, Transportation Code, as amended
- 15 by this Act, applies only to a request for approval of a project
- 16 that is submitted to the Texas Department of Transportation on or
- 17 after the effective date of this Act. A request for approval of a
- 18 project that is submitted before that date is governed by the law in
- 19 effect on the date the request for approval was submitted, and the
- 20 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
