- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 508.001, Government Code is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 508.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 7 (1) "Administrative Violation" means a technical
- 8 violation of parole or mandatory supervision which does not allege
- 9 <u>criminal conduct.</u>
- 10 $\frac{(1)}{(2)}$ "Board" means the Board of Pardons and
- 11 Paroles.
- 12 $\frac{(2)}{(3)}$ "Community supervision and corrections
- 13 department" means a department established under Chapter 76.
- 14 (3) (4) "Director" means the director of the pardons
- 15 and paroles division.
- 16 $\frac{(4)}{(5)}$ "Division" means the pardons and paroles
- 17 division.
- 18 $\frac{\text{(5)}}{\text{(6)}}$ "Mandatory supervision" means the release of
- 19 an eligible inmate sentenced to the institutional division so that
- 20 the inmate may serve the remainder of the inmate's sentence not on
- 21 parole but under the supervision of the pardons and paroles
- 22 division.
- 23 (6) (7) "Parole" means the discretionary and
- 24 conditional release of an eligible inmate sentenced to the

- 1 institutional division so that the inmate may serve the remainder
- 2 of the inmate's sentence under the supervision of the pardons and
- 3 paroles division.
- 4 (7) (8) "Parole officer" means a person appointed by
- 5 the director and assigned the duties of assessment of risks and
- 6 needs, investigation, case management, and supervision of
- 7 releasees to ensure that releasees are complying with the
- 8 conditions of parole or mandatory supervision.
- 9 (8) (9) "Parole commissioner" means a person employed
- 10 by the board to perform the duties described by Section 508.0441.
- 11 (9) (10) "Releasee" means a person released on parole
- 12 or to mandatory supervision.
- 13 (10) (11) "Presiding officer" means the presiding
- 14 officer of the Board of Pardons and Paroles.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
