7	Sec. 324.151. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only
8	to:
9	(1) an ambulatory surgical center licensed under
10	Chapter 243; and
11	(2) a hospital licensed under Chapter 241.
12	Sec. 324.152. MANDATORY DISCLOSURE ON INTERNET WEBSITE. A
13	facility subject to this subchapter shall post on the facility's
14	Internet website:
15	(1) a listing of the health benefit plans in which the
16	facility is a participating provider in the health benefit plan's
17	provider network; and
18	(2) a statement informing consumers that:
19	(A) physician services provided in the facility
20	are not included in the facility's billed charges and the consumer
21	may receive a bill for medical services from a physician for the
22	amount unpaid by the consumer's health benefit plan;
23	(B) a physician who may provide services to the
24	consumer while the consumer is in the facility may not be a

1	participating provider with the same third-party payors as the
2	facility; and
3	(C) the consumer should contact the physician
4	arranging the facility services to determine if the physician is a
5	participating provider in the provider network of the consumer's
6	health benefit plan.
7	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
