A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to lobbying by former statewide elected officers or members of their staffs; creating a criminal offense. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 572, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 572.064 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 572.064. FORMER STATEWIDE ELECTED OFFICER OR STAFF: 7 LOBBYING RESTRICTED. (a) A former elected officer elected in a 8 9 statewide election may not, before the second anniversary of the first day of the month following the date the person ceases to hold 10 the office, engage in activities that require registration under 11 Chapter 305. 12 (b) A person who is employed by and reports directly to an 13 14 elected officer elected in a statewide election in the officer's official capacity may not, before the second anniversary of the 15 16 date the person ceases to be employed by the elected officer, engage in activities that require registration under Chapter 305. 17 (c) A person who violates Subsection (a) or (b) commits an 18 offense. An offense under this subsection is a Class A misdemeanor. 19 SECTION 2. Section 572.064, Government Code, as added by 20 this Act, applies only to a person who ceases to be a statewide 21 elected officer on or after the effective date of this Act or a 22 23 person who ceases to be employed by a statewide elected officer on or after the effective date of this Act. 24

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
