3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 161.325, Health and Safety Code, is
5	amended by adding Subsection (b-1) and amending Subsection (c-1) to
6	read as follows:
7	(b-1) The programs on the list must include components that
8	provide for training counselors, teachers, nurses, administrators,
9	and other staff, as well as law enforcement officers and social
10	workers who regularly interact with students, to:
11	(1) recognize students displaying signs of physical or
12	emotional trauma; and
13	(2) intervene effectively with students described by
14	Subdivision (1) by providing the written explanation required under
15	Section 26.0081(c), Education Code, and notice and referral to a
16	parent or guardian so appropriate action, such as seeking mental
17	health or substance abuse services, may be taken by the parent or
18	guardian.
19	(c-1) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, each
20	school district shall provide training described in the components
21	set forth under <u>Subsections</u> [Subsection] (b) <u>and (b-1)</u> for
22	teachers, counselors, principals, and all other appropriate
23	personnel. A school district is required to provide the training at
24	an elementary school campus only to the extent that sufficient

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- 1 funding and programs are available. A school district may
- 2 implement a program on the list to satisfy the requirements of this
- 3 subsection.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
