SECTION 2. Section 161.325, Health and Safety Code, is 15 16 amended by adding Subsections (c-3) and (c-4) to read as follows: 17 (c-3) Each school district shall report annually to the Texas Education Agency: 18 (1) the number of teachers, principals, and counselors 19 employed by the district who have completed training under this 20 section; and 21 22 (2) the total number of teachers, principals, and 23 counselors employed by the district. 24 (c-4) The Texas Education Agency shall make the information
