- 2 relating to the establishment of a task force to study the financing
- 3 options for early childhood intervention services.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) In this section, "executive commissioner"
- 6 means the executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services
- 7 Commission.
- 8 (b) The executive commissioner shall establish a task force
- 9 to study and make recommendations regarding the feasibility of
- 10 requiring:
- 11 (1) private group health benefit plan coverage for
- 12 early childhood intervention services, including speech therapy
- 13 services, regardless of whether the services are necessitated by an
- 14 illness, injury, or cognitive defect; and
- 15 (2) private group health benefit plan issuers to
- 16 include providers of early childhood intervention services in their
- 17 provider networks.
- 18 (c) Subject to this subsection, the executive commissioner
- 19 shall determine the size and composition of the task force. The
- 20 executive commissioner shall appoint the members of the task force,
- 21 which must include representatives of:
- 22 (1) early childhood intervention services providers;
- 23 (2) advocacy groups that provide policy advocacy for
- 24 recipients of early childhood intervention services;

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- 1 (3) the Health and Human Services Commission;
- 2 (4) the Texas Department of Insurance; and
- 3 (5) private group health benefit plan issuers.
- 4 (d) Not later than December 1, 2018, the task force shall
- 5 submit a report to the appropriate standing committees of the
- 6 legislature that includes:
- 7 (1) the results of the task force's study;
- 8 (2) recommendations regarding the feasibility of the
- 9 requirements described by Subsection (b) of this section; and
- 10 (3) legislation necessary to implement the
- 11 recommendations made under Subdivision (2) of this subsection.
- 12 (e) This section expires and the task force is abolished
- 13 January 1, 2019.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
