(b) The department may develop and adopt: 15 16 (1) a process to evaluate or approve a continuing education provider or program; and 17 18 (2) a process to assess a certificate holder's or license holder's participation in a continuing education program. 19 SECTION 2. Not later than August 31, 2017, or as soon as 20 21 practicable after the effective date of this Act if more time is required, the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall 22 ensure rules are adopted as required by Section 401.5095, Health 23 24 and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
