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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to appropriations of water for use in aquifer storage and recovery projects. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.153, Water Code, is amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsections (d), (e), and (f) to 6 7 read as follows: The [This section does not preclude the] commission may 8 (c) 9 consider [from considering] an aquifer storage and recovery project to be a component of a project permitted under this chapter that is 10 not required to be based on the continuous availability of 11 12 historic, normal stream flow. (d) An aquifer storage and recovery project may involve the 13 use of water derived from multiple sources, including a new 14 appropriation of water. Except as provided by Subsection (e), a 15 16 water right or an amendment to a water right authorizing a new appropriation of water for use in an aquifer storage and recovery 17 18 project: (1) must include any special conditions the commission 19 considers necessary to implement this section; 20 21 (2) may be for water that is not continuously 22 available; 23 (3) may authorize the diversion and use of excess flows in a watercourse or stream that would otherwise flow into the 24

2	(4) may not interfere with or negatively affect:
3	(A) existing water rights in the same river basin
4	as the diversion point for the new appropriation; or
5	(B) applicable environmental flow standards
6	adopted under Section 11.1471.
7	(e) Before approving an application for a water right or an
8	amendment to a water right for a new appropriation of water in the
9	Rio Grande basin for an aquifer storage and recovery project, the
10	commission shall consider the water accounting requirements for any
11	international water sharing treaty, minutes, and agreement
12	applicable to the Rio Grande basin and the effect of the project on
13	the allocation of water by the Rio Grande watermaster in the middle
14	and lower Rio Grande. The commission may not authorize a new
15	appropriation of water that would result in a violation of a treaty
16	or court decision.
17	(f) The commission may adopt rules providing an expedited
18	procedure for acting on an application for a water right or an
19	amendment to a water right under this section.
20	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 11, Water Code, is amended
21	by adding Section 11.156 to read as follows:
22	Sec. 11.156. AMENDMENT TO CONVERT USE FROM RESERVOIR
23	STORAGE TO AQUIFER STORAGE AND RECOVERY. (a) In this section,
24	"aquifer storage and recovery project" has the meaning assigned by
25	<u>Section 27.151.</u>
26	(b) A holder of a water right authorizing an appropriation
27	of water for storage in a storage reservoir that has not been

(d) An application for an amendment to a water right 11 12 described by Subsection (b): (1) is exempt from any notice and hearing requirements 13 14 of a statute, commission rule, or permit condition and may not be referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings for a 15 contested case hearing if the application does not request: 16 17 (A) an increase in the amount of water that may be diverted or the rate of diversion; or 18 19 (B) a change in the diversion point; and (2) is subject to the notice and hearing requirements 20 of this chapter if the application requests: 21 22 (A) an increase in the amount of water that may be diverted or the rate of diversion, including an increase on the 23 24 basis of an evaporation credit; or (B) a change in the diversion point. 25 26 (e) If the commission grants an application for an amendment to a water right described by Subsection (d)(2), the commission 27
