A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to school district transportation services; authorizing a 3 fee. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 11.158, Education Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsections (a) and (f) and adding Subsection (f-1) to 6 read as follows: 7 (a) The board of trustees of an independent school district 8 9 may require payment of: (1) a fee for materials used in any program in which 10 11 the resultant product in excess of minimum requirements becomes, at 12 the student's option, the personal property of the student, if the fee does not exceed the cost of materials; 13 14 (2) membership dues in student organizations or clubs and admission fees or charges for attending extracurricular 15 16 activities, if membership or attendance is voluntary; (3) a security deposit for the return of materials, 17 supplies, or equipment; 18 (4) a fee for personal physical education and athletic 19 equipment and apparel, although any student may provide the 20 21 student's own equipment or apparel if it meets reasonable requirements and standards relating to health 22 and safety 23 established by the board; 24 (5) a fee for items of personal use or products that a

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1 charge a fee for transportation for which the school district
2 receives funds under Section 42.155(d)]; or

3 (15) a reasonable fee, not to exceed \$50, for costs 4 associated with an educational program offered outside of regular 5 school hours through which a student who was absent from class 6 receives instruction voluntarily for the purpose of making up the 7 missed instruction and meeting the level of attendance required 8 under Section 25.092[; or

9 [(16) if the district does not receive any funds under 10 Section 42.155 and does not participate in a county transportation 11 system for which an allotment is provided under Section 42.155(i), 12 a reasonable fee for the transportation of a student to and from the 13 school the student attends].

(f) Except as provided by Subsection (f-1), a [A] school district shall adopt reasonable procedures for waiving a deposit or fee if a student or the student's parent or guardian is unable to pay it. This policy shall be posted in a central location in each school facility, in the school policy manual, and in the student handbook.

20 (f-1) A school district may waive or reduce fees for 21 transportation imposed under Subsection (a)(14) for a student who 22 is socioeconomically disadvantaged, as determined by the district.

23 SECTION 2. Chapter 34, Education Code, is amended by adding 24 Section 34.0041 to read as follows:

25 <u>Sec. 34.0041. BUS STOPS. In operating a public school</u> 26 <u>transportation system, a school district may establish bus stops at</u> 27 reasonable intervals on a school bus route as necessary to reduce

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1 the costs of providing student transportation.

2 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 3 school year.

4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 the vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
