## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the issuance of a transportation network company
3	driver's license; requiring an occupational license; authorizing a
4	fee; providing a civil penalty.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. The heading to Subtitle F, Title 7,
7	Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:
8	SUBTITLE F. COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES AND PERSONAL VEHICLES USED
9	FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES
10	SECTION 2. Subtitle F, Title 7, Transportation Code, is
11	amended by adding Chapter 649 to read as follows:
12	CHAPTER 649. TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY DRIVER'S LICENSES
13	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
14	Sec. 649.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
15	(1) "Department" means the Texas Department of Motor
16	<u>Vehicles.</u>
17	(2) "Digital network" means any online-enabled
18	application, software, website, or system offered or used by a
19	transportation network company that enables a prearranged ride with
20	a transportation network company driver.
21	(3) "Personal vehicle" means a vehicle that is used by
22	a transportation network company driver and is:
23	(A) owned, leased, or otherwise authorized for
24	use by the driver; and

1	(B) not a taxicab, limousine, or similar for-hire
2	vehicle.
3	(4) "Prearranged ride" means transportation provided
4	by a transportation network company driver to a transportation
5	network company rider, beginning at the time a driver accepts a ride
6	requested by a rider through a digital network controlled by a
7	transportation network company and ending at the time the last
8	requesting rider departs from the driver's personal vehicle. The
9	term does not include:
10	(A) a shared expense carpool or vanpool
11	arrangement or service; or
12	(B) transportation provided using a taxicab,
13	limousine, or similar for-hire vehicle.
14	(5) "Transportation network company" means a
15	corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, or other entity
16	operating in this state that uses a digital network to connect a
17	transportation network company rider to a transportation network
18	company driver for a prearranged ride. The term does not include an
19	entity arranging nonemergency medical transportation under a
20	contract with the state or a managed care organization for
21	individuals qualifying for Medicaid or Medicare.
22	(6) "Transportation network company driver" means an
23	individual who:
24	(A) receives connections to potential
25	transportation network company riders and related services from a
26	transportation network company in exchange for payment of a fee to
27	the company; and

- 1 (B) uses a personal vehicle to offer or provide a
- 2 prearranged ride to a transportation network company rider on
- 3 connection with the rider through a digital network controlled by
- 4 the company in exchange for compensation or payment of a fee.
- 5 (7) "Transportation network company rider" means an
- 6 individual who uses a transportation network company's digital
- 7 network to connect with a transportation network company driver who
- 8 provides a prearranged ride to the individual in the driver's
- 9 personal vehicle between points chosen by the individual.
- 10 SUBCHAPTER B. DEPARTMENT POWERS AND DUTIES
- 11 Sec. 649.010. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE. The department shall
- 12 issue a license to a person who meets the requirements of this
- 13 chapter and rules adopted under this chapter.
- 14 Sec. 649.011. REGISTRY. The department by rule shall adopt
- 15 procedures to create and maintain a registry of all persons issued a
- 16 <u>license under this chapter.</u>
- Sec. 649.012. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The department may
- 18 take action as necessary to administer and enforce this chapter.
- 19 Sec. 649.013. RULEMAKING. The department shall adopt rules
- 20 for licensing transportation network company drivers and other
- 21 rules as necessary to implement this chapter.
- Sec. 649.014. FEES. The department by rule shall set the
- 23 fees imposed under this chapter in an amount sufficient to recover
- 24 costs of administering this chapter.
- 25 <u>Sec. 649.015. CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD.</u> The department
- 26 shall obtain from the Federal Bureau of Investigation criminal
- 27 history record information on each applicant for a license under

- 1 this chapter.
- 2 SUBCHAPTER C. REGULATION OF TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY DRIVERS
- 3 Sec. 649.021. LICENSE REQUIRED. A person may not act as a
- 4 transportation network company driver unless the person holds a
- 5 license under this chapter.
- 6 Sec. 649.022. LICENSE APPLICATION. (a) The department by
- 7 <u>rule shall establish a license application.</u>
- 8 (b) The requirements for a license must include that the
- 9 applicant:
- 10 (1) submit an application in a form prescribed by the
- 11 department;
- 12 <u>(2) pay the required fee;</u>
- 13 (3) disclose any transportation network company whose
- 14 digital network the applicant will use to provide a prearranged
- 15 ride to a transportation network company rider;
- 16 (4) provide evidence of the applicant's personal
- 17 financial responsibility for any personal vehicle the applicant
- 18 will use to provide a prearranged ride to a transportation network
- 19 company rider; and
- 20 (5) submit a complete and legible set of the
- 21 applicant's fingerprints in a form prescribed by the department.
- Sec. 649.023. TERM; RENEWAL. (a) A license issued under
- 23 this chapter expires on the first anniversary of the date of
- 24 issuance.
- 25 (b) A person may renew a license issued under this chapter
- 26 if the person:
- 27 (1) submits a renewal application in a form prescribed

- 4 Sec. 649.052. CIVIL PENALTY. A person who violates this
- 5 chapter or a rule adopted under this chapter is subject to a civil
- 6 penalty in an amount set by the department of not more than \$1,000
- 7 per violation.
- 8 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2017, the Texas
- 9 Department of Motor Vehicles shall adopt rules necessary to
- 10 implement Chapter 649, Transportation Code, as added by this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2018.
