## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to annual limitations on the reimbursement of expenses

- 3 incurred by district court reporters.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 52.055, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (d) The expenses reimbursed under this section are subject
- 9 to annual limitations based on the size of the judicial district.
- 10 Except as provided by Subsection (d-1), a [A] court reporter may not
- 11 receive more than the maximum reimbursement amount set for the
- 12 reporter's judicial district in any one year. The maximum
- 13 reimbursement amount is as follows:
- 14 (1) if the judicial district contains two counties,
- 15 the maximum reimbursement amount is \$400;
- 16 (2) if the judicial district contains three counties,
- 17 the maximum reimbursement amount is \$800;
- 18 (3) if the judicial district contains four counties,
- 19 the maximum reimbursement amount is \$1,400; and
- 20 (4) if the judicial district contains five or more
- 21 counties, the maximum reimbursement amount is \$2,000.
- (d-1) For expenses that exceed the annual maximum
- 23 reimbursement amount set for a court reporter's judicial district
- 24 under Subsection (d), the reporter may receive reimbursement from

- 1 the county for which the expenses were incurred on approval of the
- 2 <u>commissioners court of the county.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to
- 4 expenses incurred by a court reporter on or after the effective date
- 5 of this Act. Expenses incurred before the effective date of this
- 6 Act are governed by the law in effect on the date the expenses were
- 7 incurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 8 purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
