- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 52.055(d), Government Code, is amended
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (d) The expenses reimbursed under this section are subject
- 8 to annual limitations based on the size of the judicial district. A
- 9 court reporter may not receive more than the maximum reimbursement
- 10 amount set for the reporter's judicial district in any one year upon
- 11 approval of the additional reimbursement by the commissioners court
- 12 of the respective county for which the expenses were incurred. The
- 13 maximum reimbursement amount is as follows:
- 14 (1) if the judicial district contains two counties, the
- 15 maximum reimbursement amount is \$400;
- 16 (2) if the judicial district contains three counties, the
- 17 maximum reimbursement amount is \$800;
- 18 (3) if the judicial district contains four counties, the
- 19 maximum reimbursement amount is \$1,400; and
- 20 (4) if the judicial district contains five or more counties,
- 21 the maximum reimbursement amount is \$2,000..
- 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to
- 23 expenses incurred by a court reporter on or after the effective date
- 24 of this Act. Expenses incurred by a court reporter before the

- 1 effective date of this Act are governed by the law in effect on the
- 2 date the expenses were incurred, and the former law is continued in
- 3 effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
