A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the election of members of the boards of directors of
- 3 certain tax increment reinvestment zones.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 311, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 311.0092 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 311.0092. COMPOSITION OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
- 8 REINVESTMENT ZONES IN CERTAIN POPULOUS MUNICIPALITIES. (a) This
- 9 section applies to a reinvestment zone located wholly or partly in a
- 10 municipality with a population of at least two million.
- 11 (b) For purposes of this section, an area adjacent to a
- 12 reinvestment zone means any area in an election precinct any part of
- 13 which is within two miles of the zone's boundaries in any direction.
- 14 (c) The board of directors of a reinvestment zone consists
- 15 of at least 11 and not more than 15 members, unless more than 15
- 16 members are required to satisfy the requirements of this
- 17 subsection. A majority of members of the board must be elected in a
- 18 <u>nonpartisan election</u>. Each taxing unit that approves the payment
- 19 of all or part of its tax increment into the tax increment fund is
- 20 entitled to appoint a member, including the county or municipality
- 21 that designated the zone. A taxing unit may waive its right to
- 22 appoint a director. The member of the state senate in whose
- 23 district the zone is located is a member of the board, and the
- 24 member of the state house of representatives in whose district the

- 1 zone is located is a member of the board, except that either may
- 2 designate another individual to serve in the member's place at the
- 3 pleasure of the member. If the zone is located in more than one
- 4 senate or house district, this subsection applies only to the
- 5 senator or representative in whose district a larger portion of the
- 6 zone is located than any other senate or house district, as
- 7 applicable. The municipality shall hold an election to elect the
- 8 number of members to the board that results in at least 51 percent
- 9 of the members of the board being elected.
- 10 (d) An election required by this section must be held in an
- 11 even-numbered year on the uniform election date in November
- 12 authorized by Section 41.001, Election Code. A municipality may
- 13 contract with the county to hold the election.
- 14 (e) Members of the board are appointed or elected for terms
- 15 of two years unless longer terms are provided under Section 11,
- 16 Article XI, Texas Constitution. Terms of members may be staggered.
- 17 (f) Individuals residing in the zone or in an area adjacent
- 18 to the zone are eligible to vote in the election of members of the
- 19 board.
- 20 (g) A vacancy on the board is filled for the unexpired term
- 21 by appointment of the governing body of the taxing unit that
- 22 appointed the director who served in the vacant position or, if the
- 23 vacant position was an elected position, by election on the next
- 24 election date under Subsection (d) that provides sufficient time to
- 25 comply with other requirements of law.
- 26 (h) To be eligible for appointment or to be a candidate for
- 27 or be elected to the board, an individual must:

- 1 (1) be a qualified voter of the municipality and
- 2 reside in the zone or in an area adjacent to the zone; or
- 3 (2) be at least 18 years of age and own real property
- 4 in the zone or in an area adjacent to the zone or be an employee or
- 5 agent of a person that owns real property in the zone or in an area
- 6 adjacent to the zone.
- 7 (i) Each year the board of directors of a reinvestment zone
- 8 shall elect one of its members to serve as presiding officer for a
- 9 term of one year. The board of directors may elect an assistant
- 10 presiding officer to preside in the absence of the presiding
- 11 officer or when there is a vacancy in the office of presiding
- 12 officer. The board may elect other officers as it considers
- 13 appropriate.
- 14 (j) A member of the board of directors of a reinvestment
- 15 zone:
- 16 (1) is not a public official by virtue of that
- 17 position; and
- 18 (2) unless otherwise ineligible, may be appointed to
- 19 serve concurrently on the board of directors of a local government
- 20 corporation created under Subchapter D, Chapter 431,
- 21 Transportation Code.
- 22 <u>(k) This section does not apply to a tax increment</u>
- 23 reinvestment zone designated in accordance with a law other than
- 24 this chapter that provides that an entity identified in the other
- 25 law serves as the board of directors of the tax increment
- 26 reinvestment zone.
- 27 SECTION 2. Section 311.004(a), Tax Code, is amended to read

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1 as follows:
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- 2 (a) The ordinance or order designating an area as a
- 3 reinvestment zone must:
- 4 (1) describe the boundaries of the zone with
- 5 sufficient definiteness to identify with ordinary and reasonable
- 6 certainty the territory included in the zone;
- 7 (2) create a board of directors for the zone and
- 8 specify the number of directors of the board as provided by Section
- 9 311.009, [or 311.0091, or 311.0092, as applicable;
- 10 (3) provide that the zone take effect immediately upon
- 11 passage of the ordinance or order;
- 12 (4) provide a date for termination of the zone;
- 13 (5) assign a name to the zone for identification, with
- 14 the first zone created by a municipality or county designated as
- 15 "Reinvestment Zone Number One, City (or Town, as applicable) of
- 16 (name of municipality)," or "Reinvestment Zone Number One, (name of
- 17 county) County," as applicable, and subsequently created zones
- 18 assigned names in the same form numbered consecutively in the order
- 19 of their creation;
- 20 (6) establish a tax increment fund for the zone; and
- 21 (7) contain findings that:
- 22 (A) improvements in the zone will significantly
- 23 enhance the value of all the taxable real property in the zone and
- 24 will be of general benefit to the municipality or county; and
- 25 (B) the area meets the requirements of Section
- 26 311.005.
- 27 SECTION 3. (a) This section of this Act applies to a tax

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- 1 increment reinvestment zone to which Section 311.0092, Tax Code, as
- 2 added by this Act, applies.
- 3 (b) Not later than January 1, 2019, the composition and
- 4 number of members serving on the board of a tax increment
- 5 reinvestment zone must comply with the requirements of Section
- 6 311.0092, Tax Code, as added by this Act.
- 7 (c) Members required to be elected to the board of a tax
- 8 increment reinvestment zone shall be elected beginning with the
- 9 general election conducted in 2018. Members then elected take
- 10 office January 1, 2019.
- 11 (d) The change in the manner of selection of the board of
- 12 directors of a tax increment reinvestment zone does not affect the
- 13 selection of directors who serve on the board before January 1,
- 14 2019.
- 15 (e) The term of a member of the board of directors serving on
- 16 December 31, 2018, expires on January 1, 2019.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
