H.B. No. 4062

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to rules for hospital sanitation standards and а 3 limitation on certain Department of State Health Services rules. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 241.026(a), Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (a) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules and the 7 department shall enforce the rules to further the purposes of this 8 9 chapter. The rules at a minimum shall address: (1) minimum requirements for staffing by physicians 10 11 and nurses; 12 (2) hospital services relating to patient care; 13 fire prevention and [7] safety [7 and sanitation] (3) 14 requirements in hospitals; (4) patient care and a patient bill of rights; 15 compliance with other state and federal laws 16 (5) affecting the health, safety, and rights of hospital patients; 17 18 [and] (6) compliance with nursing peer 19 review under Subchapter I, Chapter 301, and Chapter 303, Occupations Code, and 20 21 the rules of the Texas Board of Nursing relating to peer review; and 22 (7) requirements for implementing standards for sanitation procedures established to prevent infection or illness 23 24 in a hospital.

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1 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 1001, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Section 1001.0745 to read as follows: 2 3 Sec. 1001.0745. LIMITATION ON RULEMAKING AUTHORITY FOR 4 CERTAIN RULES. The executive commissioner by rule may only prescribe a medical care, health care, or health care facility 5 6 standard that: 7 (1) is based on widespread and peer-reviewed 8 scientific research; and 9 (2) reflects best practices as determined by the medical community. 10 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
