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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to fetal alcohol syndrome information provided to pregnant patients. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 161, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Subchapter X to read as follows: 6 SUBCHAPTER X. INFORMATION FOR PREGNANT PATIENTS 7 Sec. 161.701. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter: 8 9 (1) "Health care provider" means: (A) a physician licensed to practice medicine in 10 11 this state; 12 (B) a physician assistant licensed under Chapter 204, Occupations Code; 13 14 (C) a midwife licensed under Chapter 203, 15 Occupations Code; (D) an advanced practice nurse as defined by 16 Section 301.152, Occupations Code; 17 18 (E) a hospital licensed under Chapter 241; or (F) a birthing center licensed under Chapter 244. 19 (2) "Medically accurate information" 20 means 21 information that is: 22 (A) verified or supported by the weight of 23 research conducted in compliance with accepted scientific methods; 24 (B) published in peer-reviewed journals, if

2	(C) recognized as accurate, objective, and
3	complete by mainstream professional organizations and agencies
4	with expertise in the relevant field, including:
5	(i) the Centers for Disease Control and
6	Prevention of the United States Public Health Service;

9	(iii) the American Academy of Pediatrics;

11	(iv) the surgeon general of the United
12	States Department of Health and Human Services.
13	Sec. 161.702. INFORMATIONAL MATERIAL PROVIDED TO PREGNANT
14	PATIENT. (a) A health care provider providing care to a pregnant
15	patient shall, during the patient's first visit with the provider
16	concerning the pregnancy, make available to the patient
17	informational material that includes medically accurate
18	information about the risks of drinking alcohol while pregnant,
19	including fetal alcohol syndrome.
20	(b) A health care provider may use the informational
21	material provided on the department's Internet website or
22	alternative informational material that provides the information
23	required by Subsection (a).
24	Sec. 161.703. DUTIES OF DEPARTMENT. (a) The department
25	shall:
26	(1) establish guidelines for the provision of the
27	information required by Section 161.702;

(2) make available on the department's Internet
 website a printable version of the medically accurate informational
 material required by Section 161.702(a); and
 (3) make the informational material required by

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5 Section 161.702 available for distribution to health care
6 providers, including at the request of a provider.

7 (b) The department may make available online and distribute 8 an existing medically accurate publication created by the 9 department or another health and human services agency as the 10 informational material required by Section 161.702.

11 <u>Sec. 161.704. LIABILITY NOT CREATED. This subchapter does</u> 12 <u>not create an obligation or duty that provides a basis for a cause</u> 13 <u>of action against a health care provider. A health care provider is</u> 14 <u>immune from administrative, civil, or criminal liability with</u> 15 <u>respect to an action taken or not taken under this subchapter.</u>

16 SECTION 2. Not later than October 1, 2017, the Department of 17 State Health Services shall make available the informational 18 material required by Subchapter X, Chapter 161, Health and Safety 19 Code, as added by this Act.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding Subchapter X, Chapter 161, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, a health care provider is not required to comply with the requirements of Section 161.702, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, before January 1, 24 2018.

25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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H.B. No. 40761 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this2 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
