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1 <u>encumbered free of all matters asserted or disclosed in the notice</u> 2 <u>and all claims or other matters asserted or disclosed in the action</u> 3 <u>in connection with which the notice was filed</u>. 4 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The change in law made by this Act applies only 5 to a certified copy of an order expunging a notice of lis pendens 6 recorded on or after the effective date of this Act. A certified 7 copy of an order expunging a notice of lis pendens recorded before

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8 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at 9 that time, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
