2	relating to the transference of certain territory from one
3	groundwater conservation district to another.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 36, Water Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter J-1 to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER J-1. TRANSFER OF CERTAIN TERRITORY
8	Sec. 36.341. PETITION TO TRANSFER. The owner of a
9	contiguous parcel of land that is greater than 1,000 acres in area
10	and is included in the territory of two or more groundwater
11	conservation districts by a petition presented to the districts may
12	request that the districts transfer portions of their territories
13	as necessary for the entire parcel to be included in the territory
14	of a single district only if:
15	(1) the districts in which the parcel of land is
16	located have regulatory authority over the same aquifer or
17	subdivision of an aquifer that underlies the parcel of land;
18	(2) the district to which the owner of the land
19	petitions the parcel of land to be transferred contains the portion
20	of the parcel of land with the greatest amount of taxable value of
21	property compared to each other portion of the parcel of land that
22	is located in another district;
23	(3) none of the land included in the parcel has been
24	transferred under this subchapter by a previous petition; and

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1 (4) all of the districts in which the parcel is located 2 agree to the transfer. 3 Sec. 36.342. REQUIREMENTS FOR PETITION. (a) A petition submitted under this subchapter must accurately describe the 4 boundaries of the parcel. The petitioner must provide a copy of the 5 petition to each district in which the land described by Section 6 36.341 is located. 7 8 (b) The petition must state the taxable value of the portion of the parcel of land in each district. 9 Sec. 36.343. HEARING. (a) Each district, on receiving a 10 petition under this subchapter, shall hold a hearing on the matter 11 12 of the transfer requested in the petition. (b) The board of each district by order shall set a time and 13 14 place to hold a hearing on the petition to include or exclude the 15 parcel in the district. The hearing may be held not earlier than the 31st day after the date on which the board issues the order. 16 17 (c) The secretary of the board shall give notice of the hearing. The notice must contain the time and place for the hearing 18 19 and a description of the parcel proposed to be annexed into or excluded from the district. 20 21 (d) The secretary shall: 22 (1) post copies of the notice in three public places in the district and one public place in the parcel proposed to be 23 24 annexed into or excluded from the district for at least 15 days before the date of the hearing; and 25 26 (2) not later than the 16th day before the date on which the hearing will be held, publish the notice once in a 27

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1 newspaper of general circulation in the county.

(e) If after the hearing the board finds that annexation of the parcel into the district or exclusion of the parcel from the district would be feasible and would benefit the district, the board may approve the annexation or exclusion by a resolution entered in its minutes. The board is not required to include or exclude all of the parcel described in the petition if the board finds that a change is necessary or desirable.

(f) If the board of each district approves the transfer on 9 the same terms, the districts may enter into an agreement to 10 effectuate the transfer of territory as the boards agree and within 11 a reasonable period of time. If a district from which territory is 12 to be excluded under this section has outstanding debt or 13 14 obligations, that district and the district to which the territory 15 is to be added shall include in the agreement terms that ensure that the debts of the originating district are not impaired by the 16 17 transfer of the territory. Sec. 36.344. NOTIFICATION OF COMMISSION. Each district 18 19 that adds or removes territory under this subchapter shall notify

20 the commission of the change in territory.

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2018.

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
