## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the transference of certain territory from one

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 36, Water Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subchapter J-1 to read as follows:

## 7 SUBCHAPTER J-1. TRANSFER OF CERTAIN TERRITORY

- 8 Sec. 36.341. PETITION TO TRANSFER. The owner of a
- 9 contiguous parcel of land that is greater than 1,000 acres in area
- 10 and is included in the territory of two or more groundwater
- 11 conservation districts by a petition presented to the districts may
- 12 request that the districts transfer portions of their territories
- 13 as necessary for the entire parcel to be included in the territory
- 14 of a single district only if:
- 15 (1) the districts in which the parcel of land is
- 16 located have regulatory authority over the same aquifer or
- 17 subdivision of an aquifer that underlies the parcel of land;
- 18 (2) the district to which the owner of the land
- 19 petitions the parcel of land to be transferred contains the portion
- 20 of the parcel of land with the greatest amount of taxable value of
- 21 property compared to each other portion of the parcel of land that
- 22 is located in another district;
- 23 (3) none of the land included in the parcel has been
- 24 transferred under this subchapter by a previous petition; and

- 1 (4) all of the districts in which the parcel is located
- 2 agree to the transfer.
- 3 Sec. 36.342. REQUIREMENTS FOR PETITION. (a) A petition
- 4 submitted under this subchapter must accurately describe the
- 5 boundaries of the parcel. The petitioner must provide a copy of the
- 6 petition to each district in which the land described by Section
- 7 <u>36.341 is located.</u>
- 8 (b) The petition must:
- 9 (1) state the taxable value of the portion of the
- 10 parcel of land in each district; and
- 11 (2) contain a statement from the district proposed to
- 12 receive the portion of the parcel of land that the district is
- 13 willing to accept the land.
- 14 Sec. 36.343. ACTIONS ON RECEIVING PETITION. (a) Each
- 15 district, on receiving a petition under this subchapter, may enter
- 16 into an agreement with the other district or districts to
- 17 effectuate the transfer of territory as requested and within a
- 18 reasonable period of time. If a district from which territory is to
- 19 be removed under this section has outstanding debt or obligations,
- 20 that district and the district to which the territory is to be added
- 21 shall include in the agreement terms that ensure that the debts of
- 22 the originating district are not impaired by the transfer of the
- 23 <u>territory</u>.
- (b) On entering the agreement, the districts shall adopt a
- 25 joint resolution approving the petition. The resolution must
- 26 provide the date on which the transfer is to be effective. On that
- 27 date, the requested land is annexed to the territory of the district

- 1 that is proposed to receive the land.
- 2 <u>Sec. 36.344. NOTIFICATION OF COMMISSION. Each district</u>
- 3 that adds or removes territory under this subchapter shall notify
- 4 the commission of the change in territory.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2018.
