Section 2001.353, Occupations Code, is amended 9 by adding Subsections (e), (f), (g), (h), and (i) to read as 10 11 follows: 12 (e) The commission may not take disciplinary action against a licensed authorized organization that has on file for a person who 13 14 participates in the conduct of bingo for the organization the person's criminal history record information obtained from a local 15 16 law enforcement agency or the Department of Public Safety that does not contain a record of a conviction for an offense involving 17 conduct described by Subsection (f). 18 (f) The commission may prohibit a person from participating 19 in the conduct of bingo for a licensed authorized organization if, 20 after notice and a requested hearing, the person is finally 21 determined to have: 22 23 (1) been convicted of an offense described by Section 24 2001.105(b);

18	(2) prohibits the person from participating in the

20	(h) A licensed authorized organization that receives a		
21	notification described by Subsection (g) may not allow the person

23	receipt of the notification.		
24	(i) The commission may take disciplinary action against a
