3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 552.003(6), Government Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(6) "Requestor" means a person who:
7	(A) submits a request to a governmental body for
8	inspection or copies of public information; or
9	(B) submits a request to an organization,
10	corporation, commission, committee, institution, or agency for
11	inspection or copies of information with a written assertion that
12	the entity is a governmental body.

- SECTION 2. Section 552.301, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- (h) An organization, corporation, commission, committee, 15 16 institution, or agency that asserts that it is not a governmental body and that receives a written request for information from a 17 requestor under this chapter must ask for a decision from the 18 attorney general about whether the entity is a governmental body if 19 there has not been a previous determination on that question. The 20 21 provisions of this subchapter that govern a request for a decision made under Subsection (a) apply to a request for a decision made 22 under this subsection to the extent those provisions are applicable 23 24 to the request made under this subsection. If the attorney general

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- 1 determines that the entity is a governmental body, the written
- 2 request from the requestor is considered received by the entity for
- 3 purposes of this chapter on the date the decision is rendered under
- 4 Section 552.306. The attorney general may adopt rules necessary to
- 5 implement this subsection.
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 552.306(a), Government Code, is amended 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Section 552.011, the attorney
- 9 general shall promptly render a decision requested under this
- 10 subchapter, consistent with the standards of due process,
- 11 determining whether the requested information is within one of the
- 12 exceptions of Subchapter C or, if applicable, whether the entity
- 13 requesting the decision under Section 552.301(h) is a governmental
- 14 <u>body</u>. The attorney general shall render the decision not later than
- 15 the 45th business day after the date the attorney general received
- 16 the request for a decision. If the attorney general is unable to
- 17 issue the decision within the 45-day period, the attorney general
- 18 may extend the period for issuing the decision by an additional 10
- 19 business days by informing the governmental body or entity
- 20 described by Section 552.301(h), as applicable, and the requestor,
- 21 during the original 45-day period, of the reason for the delay.
- SECTION 4. Section 552.324, Government Code, is amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- Sec. 552.324. SUIT BY GOVERNMENTAL BODY OR CERTAIN OTHER
- 25 ENTITIES. (a) The only suit a governmental body may file seeking
- 26 to withhold information from a requestor or that an entity
- 27 described by Section 552.301(h) may file regarding a request

- 1 <u>received from a requestor</u> is a suit that:
- 2 (1) is filed in a Travis County district court against
- 3 the attorney general in accordance with Section 552.325; and
- 4 (2) seeks declaratory relief from compliance with a
- 5 decision by the attorney general issued under Subchapter G.
- 6 (b) The governmental body or entity described by Section
- 7 552.301(h) must bring the suit not later than the 30th calendar day
- 8 after the date the governmental body  $\underline{\text{or}}$  entity receives the
- 9 decision of the attorney general under Section 552.306 [determining
- 10 that the requested information must be disclosed to the requestor].
- 11 If the governmental body or entity does not bring suit within that
- 12 period, the governmental body or entity shall comply with the
- 13 decision of the attorney general. If a governmental body wishes to
- 14 preserve an affirmative defense for its officer for public
- 15 information as provided in Section 552.353(b)(3), suit must be
- 16 filed within the deadline provided in Section 552.353(b)(3).
- SECTION 5. Section 552.325(a), Government Code, is amended
- 18 to read as follows:
- 19 (a) A governmental body, officer for public information, or
- 20 other person or entity that files a suit seeking to withhold
- 21 information from a requestor may not file suit against the person
- 22 requesting the information. An entity described by Section
- 23 <u>552.301(h)</u> that files a suit seeking to withhold information on the
- 24 basis that it is not a governmental body or seeking to establish
- 25 that it is not a governmental body may not file suit against the
- 26 person requesting the information. The requestor is entitled to
- 27 intervene in the suit.

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- 1 SECTION 6. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 2 to a request for public information received on or after the
- 3 effective date of this Act. A request for public information
- 4 received before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 5 law in effect when the request was received, and the former law is
- 6 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
