H.B. No. 4156

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to the route designation for the issuance of a permit for
3 the movement of oversize and overweight vehicles in certain
4 counties.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 623.219(b), Transportation Code, is
7 amended to read as follows:

8 (b) For a permit issued by a port authority located in a
9 county that is adjacent to at least two counties with a population
10 of 550,000 or more, the commission shall, with the consent of the
11 port authority, designate the most direct route from:

12 (1) the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 523 and
13 Moller Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using Farm-to-Market
14 Roads 523 and 1495;

15 (2) the intersection of State Highway 288 and Chlorine
16 Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using State Highway 288;

17 (3) the intersection of State Highway 288 and Chlorine
18 Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using State Highways 288 and
19 332 and Farm-to-Market Roads 523 and 1495;

20 (4) the intersection of North Velasco Boulevard and
21 South Avenue J in the city of Freeport to the entrance of Port
22 Freeport using North Velasco Boulevard and Farm-to-Market Road
23 1495; ~~and~~

24 (5) 21441 Loop 419 in the city of Sweeny to the

1 entrance of Port Freeport using Loop 419, State Highways 35 and 36,
2 and Farm-to-Market Road 1495; and

3 (6) 5261 7th Street in Bay City to the entrance of Port
4 Freeport using State Highway 35, Loop 419, State Highway 36, and
5 Farm-to-Market Road 1495.

6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
