1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the use of revenue from municipal hotel occupancy taxes  
 1-24 for a sports facility or field in certain municipalities.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 351.1078, Tax Code, is amended by adding  
 1-27 Subsections (a-1) and (c) to read as follows:

1-28 (a-1) The report described by Subsection (a)(2) shall be  
 1-29 made accessible through a link that appears in a prominent place on  
 1-30 the municipality's Internet website.

1-31 (c) At least annually, a municipality to which this section  
 1-32 applies shall compare the actual area hotel revenue that is  
 1-33 attributable to sporting events held at the sporting related  
 1-34 facility or sports field described by Section 351.101(i) to the  
 1-35 projected annual amount of that revenue anticipated by the  
 1-36 municipality to be generated as a result of the construction or  
 1-37 expansion of the facility or field. If area hotel revenue  
 1-38 attributable to sporting events held at the facility or field is  
 1-39 less than the projected amount, the municipality shall, as soon as  
 1-40 practicable, develop and implement a plan to increase that revenue.

1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-42 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-44 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-45 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
